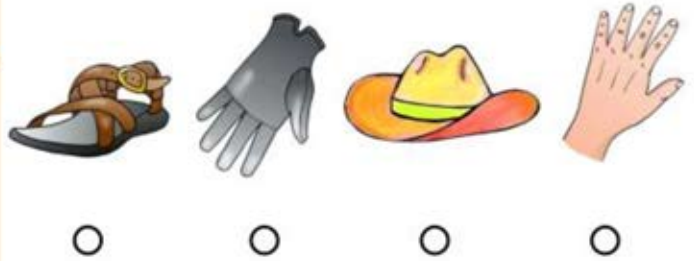
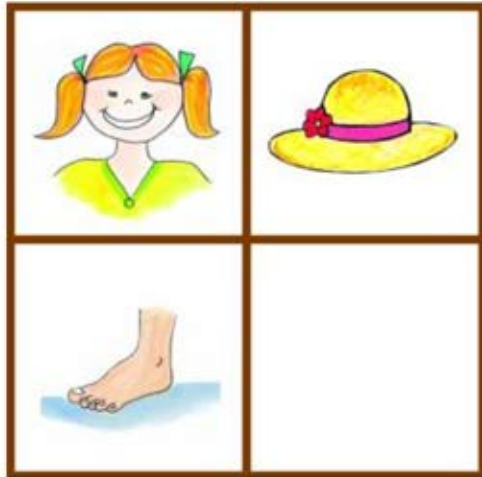


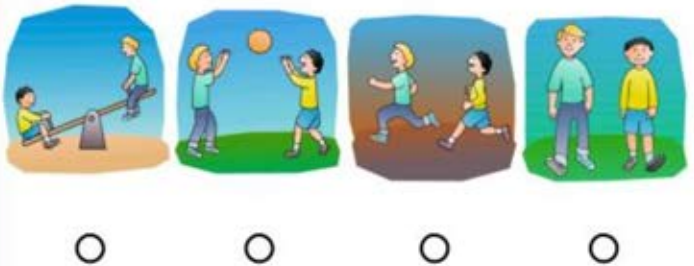
## Analogy or Matrix Questions

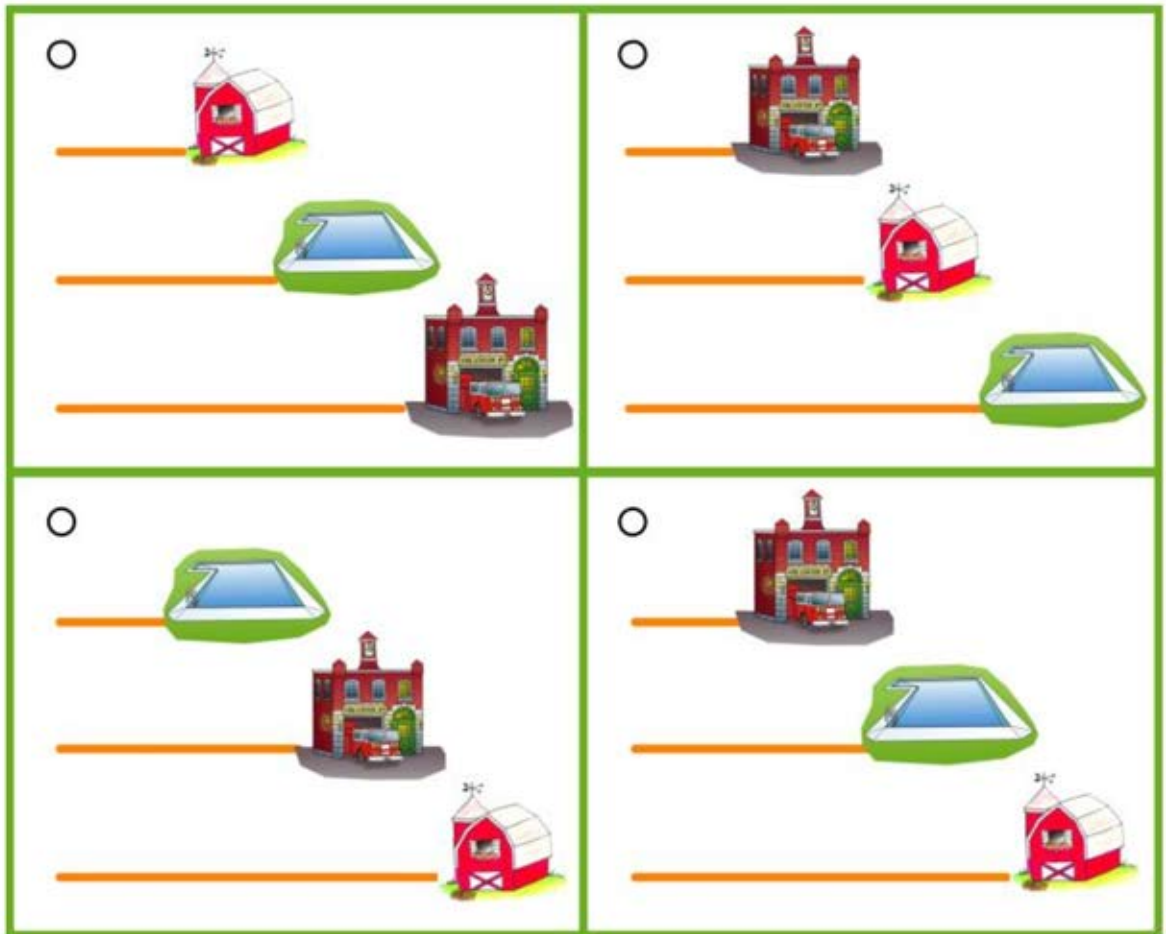



## D – 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Level
