## Using Gerund Phrases

Without gerunds, we wouldn't have jogging, swimming, and collecting. Colleges wouldn't teach accounting. Speeding wouldn't be a problem on our highways, and nothing at all would be boring. Well, perhaps those things would exist, but we would have to call them something else because the names of each of these things are gerunds.

A **gerund** is a verb form ending in *-ing* that is used as a noun. A **gerund phrase** consists of a gerund and any modifiers and complements it may have. The entire gerund phrase acts as a noun. In other words, a gerund or a gerund phrase can do anything that a noun can do.

Subject:	Flying a plane requires many hours of practice.
Indirect Object:	Why don't you give <i>flying model planes</i> a trial period?
Direct Object:	She loves <i>flying kites</i> .
Object of a Preposition:	Tell us about <i>flying the glider in Colorado</i> , Dad.

Because gerunds are a verb form, they can add action to your sentences. Try using a gerund phrase to combine two choppy sentences. It will make a more direct statement.

Original:	I baby-sit neighborhood children. I earn money that way.
Combined:	I earn money by baby-sitting neighborhood children.
Combined:	Baby-sitting neighborhood children is the way I make money.
Original:	They exercise every day. This practice is their top priority.
Combined:	Exercising every day is their top priority.
Combined:	Their top priority is <i>exercising every day</i> .
Original:	We learned twenty Japanese words. It was interesting.
Combined:	Learning twenty Japanese words was interesting.

Notice that when you use a gerund phrase to combine sentences, you need to delete some words and change others. Be sure to read over your revision carefully to be sure that it makes sense and is correctly punctuated.
